

Air Tractor SOAR (Student Outreach and Assistance Resource) Fund

Guidelines:

- Amount: US\$1000 per person per year (\$500 per semester for two semesters). If 12 or fewer students apply within a year, award will be US\$2000 per person.
- Maximum of 5 years per person (within a 7 year period) assuming other requirements are met;
 Student must re-apply every year to prove continued enrollment and GPA
- Award is available to all children or whose parent or legal guardian was killed in Air Tractor accident; (provide pilot name, date of accident, aircraft registration # for confirmation)
- Award is available to students in the United States and internationally
- Student must be attending an accredited university or junior college (provide proof of enrollment)
- Student must be enrolled at least half-time (6 hours) per semester
- After first year of receiving scholarship, student must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and at least 6-hour course load per semester to be eligible for an award the following year.
- Award checks will be written to the university for payment of student's tuition or other expenses.
 However if the student is receiving other moneys (grants, loans, etc.) that this award would affect, the check will be given to the student's parent.
- Application must be received by July 15 each year. Checks will be distributed in August or September for the following Fall semester.
- If the fund falls short of money to provide \$1000 per eligible student, Air Tractor will contribute up to \$10,000 to the fund per year to make up the difference. If this amount still does not cover all the eligible students, the fund will be equally divided among them.
- Air Tractor reserves the right to discontinue the fund at any time without prior notice.
